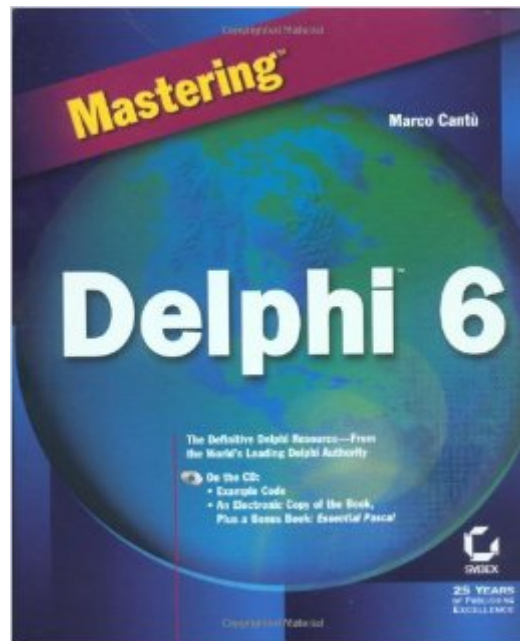

I have little to say other than this book is exceptional. All items are well covered and specific

emphasis is placed on the latest changes to the Delphi IDE as well as the latest new features in Delphi 6 (which are superb). The code examples are clear, bug free and pertinent to the topic at hand. The author's style of writing is superb. His tone is set at the right level, being both factual and very readable. The moment the book arrived, I couldn't put it down. I was a little annoyed that the section on the Pascal language was relegated to the CD, and I felt the section on SQL was sparse (also in pdf format, and on the CD only). However one could validly argue that this book is geared towards the intermediate + level of programmer, and the reader should already be familiar with these topics. Advanced programmers (a status which I have not yet attained) may be disappointed with topics covered in the client/server sections. 5 stars, once again Mr Cantu! Strongly recommended for intermediate programmers.

This book does an excellent job of walking the user through all the basics of Delphi and Object Pascal. It does assume some familiarity with Pascal, but if the reader has that, this is an extremely easy to follow book. The examples are useful, and are explained well enough that the reader can easily expand them to meet his own needs

I'm seriously considering writing my own book on programming, since there is a huge hole to be filled. From what I've seen the majority of books cater to advanced programmers, which is unfair and unfortunate. You can't start in the deep end. It's also like that in other fields as well. If you are new to Delphi don't buy this book, you won't derive much from it. The topics covered obviously deal with more advanced issues. Sharp looking cover though.

A useful compilation especially of tips and tricks, but arguably not comprehensive enough in either scope or depth. Don't think that buying this book will let you off reading the Delphi help files, or looking elsewhere for basic reference material.

The author covers development in Delphi from the fundamentals of Object Oriented Programming to some of the "hidden" and undocumented features of Delphi. Not exactly a reference, but a cover-to-cover overall conceptual tome (1503 pages!) You will be knowledgeable enough to get into some serious projects with this monster. Even aspects of design and user-proofing are covered, so it's more than just a Delphi book - it's a programming book with Delphi as the development tool.

This is a fantastic work. Cantu has an excellent summary of the new language features added to Delphi 4, and notes pitfalls which may occur when compiling old code. I generally only refer to books when I'm stuck and need help beyond the online docs. I can sit down and just read this one; there's so much useful information in it that I always find something helpful.

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
