We originally checked this out at the library... after maxing out on the renewals I knew it was a book we needed to purchase... he loves it. The flaps lift both up and to the side and every page is colorful, with a cute little rhyming story about gardening. He dies laughing every time he gets to the slugs illustration. Great purchase!

I bought this board book for my little one because daddy loves to garden and now our little one can learn about our garden. The flip pages are great for my little to improve fine motor skills and the fact that the book is printed on 80% recycled paper with soy ink, and a water based varnish, is excellent :) I don't have to worry about my little ingesting any nasty chemicals from chewing on the pages :) Hope you enjoy this board book as much as our family!

The Little Gardener is a remarkably true-to-life depiction of what it's like to garden, including the necessary evil of eliminating slugs. The flaps are not only sturdy, but easy for little hands and minds to work. The text rhymes although the rhythm isn't perfect. My toddler loves the patterns on all of the flowers and is especially excited by the basket-full of carrots in the second half of the book, but then carrots are our favorite food! I have mixed feelings about the inclusion of text that discusses getting rid of slugs--seems a little advanced for a toddler--but "slug" is a fun word for toddler ears, so we just use that page as an opportunity to play around with the "S" sound.

I included this book in a pail with seeds, bulbs, garden gloves and a trowel for an almost three-year old girl. She loved the book. I had to read it at least four times in the first twenty minutes after she emptied her pail.

I bought this book for my 20 month old because we just started working in the garden. She loves lifting the flaps and pointing to the different sight words she identifies, the illustrations are wonderful. It's a great simple introduction of the seed to table concept for toddlers. One of my new favorite board books!

Got this book to introduce gardening to an 18 month old tot. He loves lifting up the flaps and looking at the colors. He is currently a big help in the garden and loves watering his plants. This is an excellent book to help get kids interested in working in the garden

We love this book! The illustrations are sweet and colorful. My 14-month-old daughter pulls this book off her shelf to look at all time. We have read it almost every day since she received it for her first birthday. I enjoy the topic and plan to purchase another book by the same author.
